HEARTWOOD PROGRAM

What Is The Heartwood Program?

This program offers individualized or small-group tutoring to aid in academic development. It supports students aiming to exceed academic expectations and those needing help catching up or recovering from setbacks. The program is adaptable for individual, small group, or large group sessions, tailored by Middle Tree to meet each partner's specific needs.

Program Overview

This program supports all students and is designed to enhance academic experiences beyond the classroom. Inspired by "Just-in-time teaching (JITT)," we integrate schoolwork or homework as presession activities to build on students' prior knowledge. Additional online resources, supplement learning, and introductory activities identify knowledge gaps and prepare students for lessons. Heartwood aligns with educational standards by integrating classroom assignments, with tutors adjusting tactics in real-time to support student progress and academic engagement effectively. The key differentiator between Middle Tree and other organizations is the personalized Middle Tree Plans that we give to each student.

Design & Implementation

The Heartwood program is designed to address the needs of students who need support in specific academic areas. This program offers additional resources and time with the student to help align classroom academic expectations with academic guidelines. To properly execute HDT, Middle Tree uses the following guidelines:

Timeline	Group Size	Frequency	Length	Staff	Material
At least 10 weeks or 50 hours in a semester	No more than five students	Two to five sessions per week	At least 30 minutes, ideally 60 minutes	Consistently trained and supervised	Customized for the student

Middle Tree will procure additional solutions or develop curriculum to support the students enrolled in the program (as needed for partners). Staff undergo thorough testing before working with students to ensure alignment with program goals and expectations.

STEM & LEAF PROGRAM

What Is The STEM & LEAF Program?

This program immerses students in an engaging educational journey with enrichment classes in Science, Technology, Engineering, Math (STEM*), and Art and Drama/Theater (LEAF**). Our STEM & LEAF program transcends traditional education by incorporating recreation and personalized learning experiences.

Program Overview

This program is designed to provide interactive, hands-on learning experiences beyond the classroom. Our programs ignite curiosity and love for subjects often seen as challenging or overlooked in traditional education. Middle Tree enriches STEM through engaging Science classes and makes art meaningful with Art, Drama/Theater, and Recreation classes. Each session includes a demonstration followed by hands-on student participation, emphasizing practical learning to bring concepts to life.

*STEM encompasses Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics, ensuring accessibility through focused Science classes

Meeting Standards & Requirements

Our program's content will be aligned with Common Core State Standards in both English Language Arts and Literacy and Mathematics to ensure lessons are appropriate for all students. Students will be placed in classes suitable for their age group.

All Middle Tree programs integrate principles from Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS), Social Emotional Learning (SEL), and Trauma-Informed Practices (TIP). Our quality staff combines these frameworks with research-supported supervision and engagement techniques to ensure an optimal and enriching environment for students.

CANOPY PROGRAM

What Is The Canopy Program?

This program encompasses our STEM & LEAF and Heartwood programs while adding recreation and nutrition components. It aligns with the Expanded Learning Opportunities Program, ensuring a well-rounded and enriching experience for every student.

Program Overview

The "Canopy" program is designed to include daily variations of enrichment, homework help, and recreational activities along with a snack. Embedded enrichment services are based on Middle Tree's "STEM and LEAF" and "Heartwood" programs, offering short, engaging lessons in science, art, drama/theater, recreation, and tutoring. These topics can be emphasized or adjusted at the partner's discretion to create a more unique program offering that aligns with the partner's goals. Middle Tree values individualizing the student experience and aims to provide a tailored experience for each partner as well.

Behavioral Technicians
